IMF Names New Head of its Administration Department

Michel Camdessus, the Managing Director of the International Monetary Fund (IMF) has appointed K. Burke Dillon as Director of the IMF's Administration Department, effective February 1, 1995. Ms. Dillon, a national of the United States, succeeds Graeme Rae who is retiring from the IMF.

Ms. Dillon, 49, joined the IMF in 1973 as an economist, and has held a number of positions in the African and former Exchange and Trade Relations Departments. Since 1993, she has been Chief Economist at the IMF's Resident Representative Office in Moscow. In 1979 and 1980 Ms. Dillon served as Senior Staff Economist for Money, Finance, and Housing at the U.S. President's Council of Economic Advisers. Before joining the IMF, she was a Ford Foundation Africa Fellow at the Institute for Development Studies, University of Nairobi. Ms. Dillon holds degrees in economics from Northwestern University, the London School of Economics, and Yale University.
