Subject: Executive Board Travel

The Secretary has received the following memoranda:

1. From Mr. de Groote, November 25, 1992:

Would you please inform the Executive Board that I intend to travel to Brussels, Luxembourg, Bratislava, Prague and Ankara on official Fund business for consultation with my authorities.

I shall be leaving Washington on Monday, November 30, 1992 and will be back to Washington on/or about Monday, December 14, 1992.

2. From Mr. Kagalovsky, dated November 30, 1992:

Please advise the Executive Board that I will be traveling to Frankfurt, on official Fund business to attend the London Club negotiations on the former U.S.S.R. debt which will be held on December 1-4. I plan to leave Washington on Monday, November 30, 1992 and return on or about Friday, December 4, 1992.

3. From Mr. Schoenberg, dated November 30, 1992:

Would you please inform the Executive Board that I intend to travel to Germany on official Fund business. I plan to leave Washington on December 7 and to return on December 10, 1992.

In the absence of objection by the close of business on Tuesday, December 1, 1992, the travel will be deemed approved by the Executive Board and it will be so recorded in the minutes of the next meeting thereafter.
