Subject: Executive Board Travel

The Secretary has received the following memoranda:

1. From Mr. Filosa, dated December 3, 1992:

Could you please advise the Executive Board that my Alternate, Mr. Ioannis Papadakis, will be traveling on official Fund business to Athens, Greece to consult with his authorities. Mr. Papadakis will leave Washington on December 19 and return on or about January 3, 1993. While in Athens, Mr. Papadakis will spend some days on personal business.

2. From Mr. Kafka, dated December 3, 1992:

Please inform the Executive Board that on official business of the Fund and at the request of our Dominican Republic authorities, my advisor, Mr. Luis M. Piantini will be traveling to Santo Domingo. Would you please inform the Executive Board that I will be traveling to Ottawa on official Fund business in connection with the second part of Canada's Article IV consultations. I propose to leave Washington on Monday, December 14, and to return on or about Wednesday, December 16, 1992.
