Dear Mr. Camdessus,

I have the honor to request that Republic of Slovenia be admitted to full membership of the International Monetary Fund under Article II, Section 2 of the Fund's Articles of Agreement.

To enable you and the members of the Fund to evaluate our request, the Republic of Slovenia is ready to receive a fact-finding mission of the Fund as soon as can be arranged. The Government of Republic of Slovenia will be greatly obliged to receive, at your earliest convenience, a notification on a timeframe and demands of the mission.

The authorities of the Republic are willing to discuss all remaining problems and implications connected to the historical membership of SFR Yugoslavia. We can assure you that the Government of Republic of Slovenia is ready to discuss every possible modality of succession.

We wish to take this opportunity to reaffirm the intention of both the Government and the Central Bank of Republic of Slovenia to follow the policies of respecting and servicing pertinent international obligations of its entities as a matter of prime importance and to adhere to the principles of monetary, credit and foreign exchange policies supported by the Fund.
