Regular Election of Executive Directors

It was indicated in EBD/92/122, (6/16/92), that it was virtually certain that for the two years ended July 31, 1992, the two members extending the largest amount of credit as calculated for the purpose of Article XII, Section 3(c) would be the United States and Japan.

Final calculations of average credit under Article XII, Section 3(c) have been made for the two years ended July 31, 1992 and the ranking of the ten largest creditors is as follows:
