Subject: Developmental Learning

The Committee on Administrative Policies has considered a proposal on an extension of developmental learning by facilitating access to graduate level study under Individual Study Program III (ISP III) EB/CAP/90/1 (3/15/90). Although some Committee members favored adoption of the original proposal for reimbursement of only one half of the fees for the approved course, there was a majority in the Committee in favor of recommending to the Executive Board the adoption of the following draft decision:

The "Individual Study Program III" policy is expanded to include support for developmental learning through courses or programs at the graduate level in the main areas of work in the Fund. The Fund will reimburse 75 percent of the tuition and laboratory fees for the approved courses that are successfully completed and that have been approved by the Fund in advance.
