Today the Czech and Slovak Federal Republic became a member of the International Monetary Fund. The IMF's Articles of Agreement were signed on behalf of Czechoslovakia by the Federal Minister of Finance, Mr. Vaclav Klaus. The new member's quota in the IMF is SDR 590 million (about US\$826 million).

Membership now totals 152 countries, and, with the admission of Czechoslovakia, the total of members' quotas in the IMF is SDR 90,722.6 million (about US\$127,011.6 million).
