The People's Republic of Bulgaria became a member of the International Monetary Fund on September 25, 1990. The IMF's Articles of Agreement were signed on behalf of Bulgaria by Mr. Belcho Belchev, Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Finance. Bulgaria's quota in the IMF is SDR 310 million (about US\$434 million).

With the admission of Bulgaria, membership now totals 153 countries, and the total of members' quotas in the IMF is SDR 91,032.6 million (about US \$127,445.6 million).
