Helen B. Junz, a national of the United States, has been appointed Special Trade Representative and Director of the International Monetary Fund's Office in Geneva, succeeding Eduardo Wiesner who has been elected an Executive Director of the World Bank. Mrs. Junz joined the Fund in 1982 as a Senior Advisor in the European Department, and held the position of Deputy Director of the Exchange and Trade Relations Department prior to her present appointment.

Mrs. Junz was educated in the Netherlands and the United States, receiving her M.A. in Economics from the New School for Social Research, New York. Before joining the Fund, Mrs. Junz held the positions of Economic Advisor, Organization of Economic Cooperation and Development (OECD); Advisor, Division of International Finance, Board of Governors of the Federal Reserve System; Senior International Economist, U.S. Council of Economic Advisors; Deputy Assistant Secretary for Commodities and Natural Resources, U.S. Department of the Treasury; Vice President, First National Bank of Chicago; and Vice President, Townsend-Greenspan and Company Inc., New York.
