The IMF Institute, in collaboration with the African Department and the Bureau of Statistics, conducted a Seminar on Monetary and Financial Analysis in Algeria from February 7 to 16. The seminar was part of the Institute's external training program, which supplements the courses the Institute offers at Fund headquarters. The Central Bank of Algeria hosted the seminar.

The Fund team consisted of Messrs. Jean-Marie Parmentier (Head--INS), Philippe Marciniak (AFR), and Gérard Raymond (STA). There were 24 participants. Five were government officials, eighteen were from the public banking system, and one from the University of Algiers. The authorities were responsible for the selection of participants. The list of participants is shown in Attachment I.

The IMF Institute prepared the list of topics in consultation with the African Department and the Central Bank of Algeria. The list is shown in Attachment II. The program included nine lectures on macro-economic analysis and financial programming. There were also seven workshops during which the participants worked in groups to prepare for the plenary sessions.

(National accounts. Price and wage statistics. Determinants of output, income, expenditure, and savings. Review of economic developments in recent years in Algeria.)

(Government finance statistics. Treasury and social security accounts. Interpretation of the current and overall balances. Role and evolution of taxes and expenditure. Impact of public enterprises on fiscal situation. Financing the overall deficit.)

3. The Monetary Sector

(Monetary and banking statistics. Sectorization of the economy. Consolidation of monetary data. Monetary and banking surveys. Role of money, credit, and interest rates in the economy.)

4. The External Sector

(Balance of payments statistics. Determinants of exports, imports, and capital flows. Interpretation of the current account and the overall balance. Role of exchange rates and external reserves. External debt management.)



5. Relationship Among Macroeconomic Aggregates

(Relationship among the accounts and among the sectors. Role and impact of the private and public sectors on the economy. Impact of the external sector in financing the domestic deficit. Analysis of flow of funds. Comparison with other oil exporting economies.)

II. Introduction to Financial Programming

(Conceptual framework of financial programming. The use of macro-economic data in financial programming. The technical approach: identification of the problems, definition of targets, choice of instruments, compatibility problems, forecasting techniques, performance criteria. Role of the Fund in the adjustment process.)
