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

Subject: Morocco - Statistical Appendix

This appendix provides statistical background information to the staff report on the 1986 Article IV consultation discussions with Morocco which was circulated as SM/86/197 on August 8, 1986. It updates the analytical and statistical tables contained in the paper on recent economic developments in Morocco issued last year (SM/85/193, 7/3/85). No major changes have occurred in Morocco's institutional and economic structure since then.


