The Managing Director has received today the following memorandum from Mr. de Maulde:

My Minister, Mr. Pierre Bérégovoy, has asked me to convey to you the following message:

Subject: Attack on the European Office of the IMF in Paris

Dear Sir:

The European Office of the IMF has just been bombed. While significant damage appears to have been done, fortunately no one was hurt.

I wanted to express to you the indignation I feel over this terrorist act, which I condemn with the greatest vigor.

I should be grateful if you could pass this message on to the Executive Directors and staff of the Fund, whose sense of shock I share.

Accept, Sir, the assurances of my high consideration.
