In the attached telex dated September 17, 1985, the Viet Nam authorities notified the staff that, as from September 14, 1985, the State Bank of Viet Nam has been authorized to issue new dong and to withdraw old dong from circulation. The new dong has a value equal to 10 of the old dong. They have also informed that, effective September 15, 1985, the exchange rate of the new dong against the U.S. dollar has been adjusted to D 15 = US\$1; the official exchange rate of the old dong was D 12.06 = US\$1.

The staff will be in contact with the authorities to obtain further information. No action by the Executive Board is required at this time.

WE WISH TO INFORM YOU THAT (1) IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE DECREE OF THE STATE COUNCIL AND THE DECISION OF THE COUNCIL OF MINISTERS OF THE GOVERNMENT OF THE S.R.V.N., THE STATE BANK OF VIET NAM IS AUTHORISED FROM SEPTEMBER 14, 1985 TO ISSUE NEW VIET NAM DONG AND TO WITHDRAW THE OLD ONES FROM CIRCULATION WITH THE PURCHASING POWER OF THE FORMER IS TEN TIMES OVER THE LATTER. (2) EFFECTIVE FROM SEPTEMBER 15, 1985 THE EXCHANGE RATE OF VIET NAM DONG AGAINST U.S. DOLLAR IS ADJUSTED TO DONG 15 = US DOLLAR 1.
