Subject: United Kingdom – Notifications of Restrictions under Executive Board Decision No. 144 (52/51)

In accordance with Executive Board Decision No. 144-(52/51), I wish to notify the IMF of restrictions on payments and transfers for current international transactions imposed by the United Kingdom and related solely to the preservation of national or international security.

Pursuant to the [Sanctions and Anti-Money Laundering Act 2018](#), the UK has implemented the following sanctions regime, implementing UN Security Council (UNSC) Resolution 2653 (2022):

- **[Haiti – Haiti \(Sanctions\) Regulations 2022](#)**. This sanctions regime gives effect to the UK's relevant UN obligations and has been implemented in view of the situation in Haiti and discourage actions that threaten the peace, security, or stability of Haiti.

The Regulations were made on 5 December 2022 and came into force on 28 December 2022. Further information can be found at the above link.
